### **THIS IS AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT TO ALL STRAND RESIDENTS - Update 2:**

With Hurricane Irma now passed, we wanted to give everyone an update on how it impacted the Strand Community. This update is based on reports from those who stayed at the Strand during the hurricane as well as from our Property Manager. From what we have heard at this time:

1. The Strand did not suffer any flooding damage from storm surge. Our streets are about 15 ft. to 16 ft. above sea level. From the weather reports, storm surge peaked at about 6-8 ft (depending on the location). From what we understand, most flooding was west of 41 and south towards downtown Naples. We did have several lakes that overflowed their banks, but we do not know the extent of the area impacted at this time - hopefully it was confined to just the golf course area.
2. Electrical power was out at the Strand from about 11:30 AM on Sunday. More than likely this was a controlled shutdown to save the system. We've experienced the same thing during Hurricane Sandy. With power out, phone service is probably out (if via Comcast). It is best to use cell service to contact anyone. However that is sporadic (due to cell tower power) - you might just get a person's voice mail since service might be down. We would think electrical power would be out for a week or so.

3. There were a number of palms and trees blown down and blocking parts of Strand Blvd. Also, at the Strand shopping center area, there are reports of some sign and light pole damage. We are in the process of arranging with our landscaper the cleanup of Strand Blvd.

4. We don't know at this time if there were any major structural damage to homes or condos, but initial indications from those at the Strand is that damage was limited to pool cages and lanai screens. Reports are that a number of pool cages have been completely destroyed, while in other areas, lanai screens have been destroyed.
