THIS IS AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT TO ALL STRAND RESIDENTS - Update 5:

This is Update 5 for Hurricane Irma and its impact to the Strand Community.

Some minor updates from neighbors that have sent us information:

1. There is still no power at the Strand but there is power at Publix (via a generator). We have heard of power being restored at some sections in various communities, namely: Spanish Wells, Heritage Bay and Twin Eagles, Pebblebrook by Gulf Coast High School and in houses by the library on Orange Blossom. Additionally, Hawthorne, which is off of Imperial Road north of Bonita Beach Road got power restored this morning.

A note from Collier School system is that they have power to 6 of the 54 schools in the District. They are estimated school may be reopened September 20 at the earliest.

Once we have notification of power at the Strand we will send out a quick email blast.

2. Please note that if you plan on traveling by car back to the Strand, there are reports of long lines at gas stations that have power. Also remember that some areas are still without city water. As of today, Collier County Water Authority is at the Strand and making repairs. However, if the line

from the meter going to your unit or house was damaged, that would be the homeowners responsibility to repair.

3. We are working on getting a few pictures of the Strand Community posted on our web site. Attached below are some of Strand Blvd and the golf course.

Finally, most of Strand Blvd. has been cleared to allow traffic but debris is still along the side of the roadway and will be cleared as soon as crews are available. Some of the communities are also clearing their neighborhood area and roadways. However, with no electrical power, there is no fuel available for trucks to haul the debris away.
