THIS IS AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT TO ALL STRAND RESIDENTS - Update 6:

This is Update 6 for Hurricane Irma and its impact to the Strand Community.

Some updates from neighbors that have sent us information:

1. There is still no power at the Strand but there is power at Publix (via a generator) along with limited wi-fi service. It appears Carlton Lakes has sections with power.

Once we receive power at the Strand we will send out a quick email blast.

2. Please note that if you plan on traveling by car back to the Strand, there are reports of long lines at gas stations that have power. Collier County Water Utilities is at the Strand and making repairs.

The news releases include: when they will start picking up yard waste due to Hurricane Irma (we need to verify it this includes all gated communities like the Strand); recommendations for conservation of water; and FEMA

assistance forms. Please take a moment to review these important messages.

4. Below are some additional pictures from Fairway Court after the Hurricane. Additionally, we have provided a link to pictures submitted by members and some videos taken by Rick Tessmer. One is of Trophy Club and the other is of Strand Blvd. before the cleanup. You can access them at the following link:

When you are on the web-page, click on the picture with the play symbol. If the videos doesn't play automatically (may take a few minutes to load), you will need to download it and watch on your computer. These videos are long and take about 3 minutes to download for viewing. As we get more pictures and videos, we will upload them to this site.

5. We have updated our Strand Master Web Site to include these updates and added a slide show of images we have received. These updates are found under the "Emergency Information" tab. Our web site is located at the bottom of this update.

6. **IMPORTANT:** You may be aware that there are several sewage lift stations located along Strand Blvd. and near the Strand Bridge. Without power these stations are not operational and thus flow of sewage is being impeded. This is a concern that some areas may experience sewage backup if we don't get power back soon. If you are at the Strand, please be aware and let us know if any of this is occurring.

Collier County Public Utilities advises residents countywide of the critical need to reduce water usage. Under no circumstances should residents be using dishwashers, clothes washers, or otherwise putting water into the sewer system. Due to the high volume of water entering the waste water collection system, the county is experience sanitary sewer overflows across the county.

Poinciana Pine Ridge area has numerous homes with sewer backup.

As we learn more information, we will update you.
