THIS IS AN IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT TO ALL STRAND RESIDENTS - Update 7:

This is Update 7 for Hurricane Irma and its impact to the Strand Community.

MAJOR UPDATE:

1. There is still no power at the Strand but there is power at sections of Bonita Springs and Mediterra. It appears they are moving section by section towards us. Talis Park is still without power.

Once we receive power at the Strand we will send out a quick email blast.

2. Per the update yesterday, I mentioned that due to the loss of power, several sewage lift stations located along Strand Blvd. and near the Strand Bridge cannot move sewage. This is a concern that some areas may experience sewage backup if we don't get power back soon.

JUST IN: Per David at the Gate House, Collier County is at the Strand and they will be shutting off all water service to the Strand due to the sewage issues. They are looking at getting a few septic pumping trucks in to pump out the lift stations. We don't know if Collier County will turn the water back on even if the lift stations can be cleared. They might wait until power is restored for the system to operate properly.

At the suggestion from Strand resident Vic Kleinfelter, the Master Association is also pursuing contracting with some firms to pump out the lift stations (if legally possible). We'll keep you updated.

3. From the last update, Collier County has issued a number of news releases which can be accessed at the following link:

The news releases include: when they will start picking up yard waste due to Hurricane Irma (we need to verify it this includes all gated communities like the Strand); recommendations for conservation of water; and FEMA assistance forms. Please take a moment to review these important messages.

4. Below is a picture submitted by Phil Gallucci showing the eye of Hurricane Irma passing over the Strand. The Strand is the blue dot.

As we learn more information, we will update you.


